
<u>Analysis of Survey of Behavior Specialist Consultant Services for Children and Adolescents</u> with Autism Spectrum Disorders (ASD)

Question 1: How many of your members who are under the age of 21 and have a diagnosis of Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) are currently authorized to receive Behavior Specialist Consultant – Autism Spectrum Disorder (BSC-ASD) services?


The graph below shows the number of children under age 21 who are authorized to receive BSC-ASD services in each BH-MCO network and compares that number to the total number of children under age 21 covered by that BH-MCO network.


Question 2: Provide the following information: number of members who received a new authorization for BSC-ASD services in April 2015; number of those members who began receiving services within 30 days of authorization; number of those members who began receiving services between 31 and 60 days of the authorization; and, number of those members who did not begin receiving services within 60 days of the authorization.

The following graph shows the number of members who received a new authorization for BSC-ASD in April 2015 for each BH-MCO and compares it to the number of members that received services within the time frames described in question 2.



Question 3: For each provider agency in your network that provides BSC-ASD services, submit the following information about the individuals who deliver BSC-ASD services: name of individual, name and address of agency, license type, does the individual provide ABA, is the individual a Board-Certified Behavioral Analyst (BCBA), does the individual have a Master's Degree which includes a primary focus in ABA or behavioral interventions, does the individual have a graduate certificate in ABA, has the individual received training related to ABA?
