Attachment-Based Family Therapy (ABFT) is the only manualized, empirically informed family therapy model specifically designed to target family and individual processes associated with adolescent suicide and depression. ABFT emerges from interpersonal theories that suggest adolescent depression and suicide can be precipitated, exacerbated or buffered against by the quality of interpersonal relationships in families. It is a trust-based, emotion-focused psychotherapy model that aims to repair interpersonal ruptures and rebuild an emotionally protective, secure-based parent-child relationship.

Currently a visiting professor and Interim Director of the PhD program in the Couple and Family Therapy department at Drexel University's College of Nursing and Health Professions, Dr. Diamond is the primary developer of, and has received support from several state and national foundations to fund his work on, ABFT. Along with his colleagues Drs. Gary Diamond and Suzanne Levy, Dr. Diamond's first ABFT treatment manual titled *Attachment-Based Family Therapy for Depressed Adolescents*, published in October 2013 by the American Psychological Association.
