PURPOSE: To communicate to the above entities that Temple University's Institute on Protective Services will be facilitating a Forum for Certified Investigators (Cis).

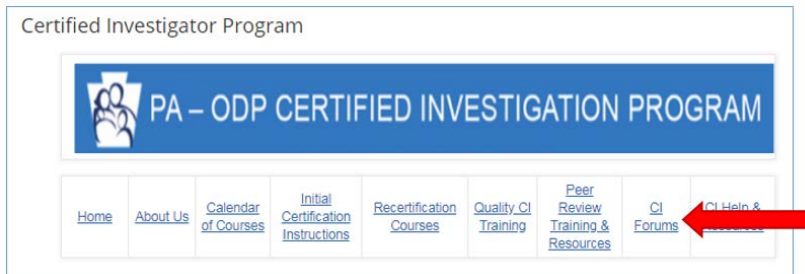

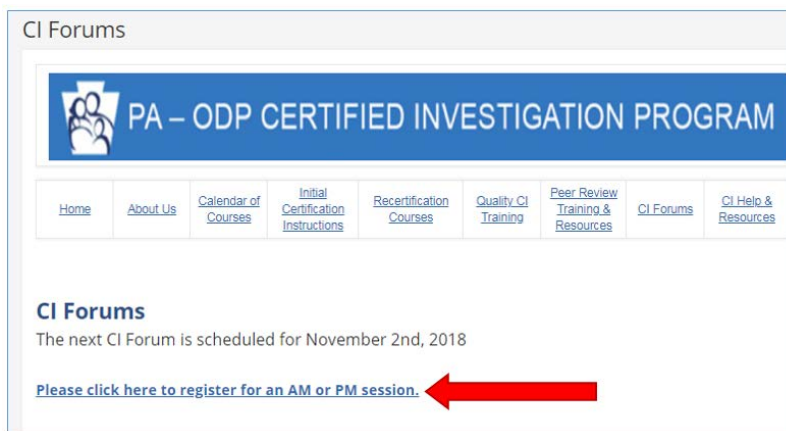
How do you register for the CI Forum:

3. Log into myODP (If you do not have a myODP account, you can create one on this page)

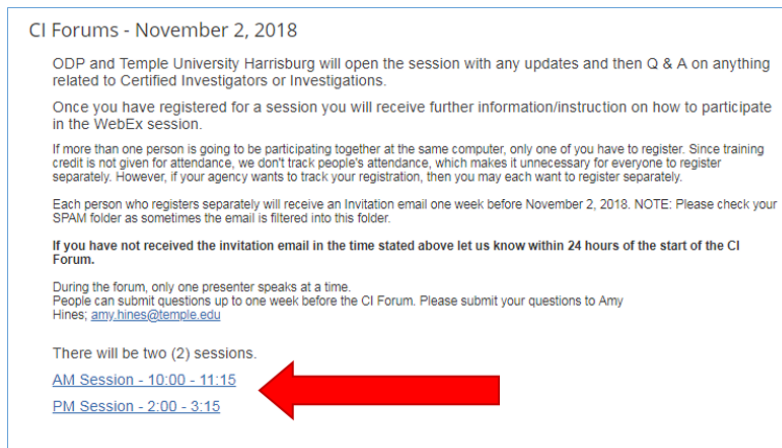
4. Click on the CI Forums link.
