

ODP Residential and Non-Residential HCBS Provider Settings Self-Assessment Reports ODP Announcement 19-149

AUDIENCE:

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this communication is to release the Residential and Non-Residential Home and Community-Based Services (HCBS) Provider Settings Self-Assessment Reports.

DISCUSSION:

In March 2014, the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) implemented a final rule related to HCBS Settings. This final rule requires that states assess all residential and non-residential settings which receive funding or payment through an approved HCBS waiver. To comply with this requirement, the Office of Developmental Programs (ODP) chose to begin by developing a self-assessment to be completed for residential and non-residential service locations. Providers completed the self-assessment in 2018 for over 6,000 Residential and Non-Residential service locations.

The data from the self-assessments were analyzed and two reports were created:

- A Residential HCBS Provider Settings Self-Assessment Report based on the data submitted from providers for homes where Residential Habilitation, Life Sharing, or Family Living is rendered; and
- A Non-Residential HCBS Provider Settings Self-Assessment Report based on the data submitted from providers for locations where Community Participation Support and/or Day Habilitation services are rendered.

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Each report attached contains the history of the HCBS Settings Rule, the methods that were used in assessing each service location, the results of the self-assessments, and the next steps that will be taken to ensure compliance with HCBS Settings Rule.
