Request for Applications: Naloxone for First Responders Program



To further align with the Wolf Administration's goals in battling the opioid crisis, Pennsylvania's Opioid Command Center and Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency have released updated program guidelines for the Naloxone for First Responders Program and are requesting applications for eligible organizations to serve as Centralized Coordinating Entities (CCEs).

As with the current program, each county or region will designate one CCE to distribute Narcan locally to priority first responder groups. In addition to the county/regional CCEs, the Administration is inviting statewide agencies and/or organizations to serve as a Statewide CCEs to provide Narcan to a specific first responder group and/or priority population.
