### Ethics

The Pennsylvania Department of Drug & Alcohol Programs (DDAP) is exploring ways to provide required trainings during the Covid-19 outbreak. #### How to Attend

The registration for this training is limited to 30 individuals. Everyone who wishes to participate in this training must register individually and log into each session using their own device; DDAP does not allow multiple individuals to participate as a group using one registration and device.
