DDAP Announces SUD Confidentiality Requirements Survey



The Pennsylvania Department of Drug and Alcohol Programs (DDAP) is seeking stakeholder feedback on Pennsylvania's Substance Use Disorder (SUD) confidentiality requirements. We want to know how these requirements are working and if they can be improved. As part of these efforts, an <u>online survey</u> will be open to the public from **today**, **May 13 through August 31.** You can find more information about this project, as well as information on current SUD Confidentiality Requirements, on the <u>DDAP</u> <u>website</u>. DDAP is also asking RCPA members to disseminate the survey to their agency staff because it will help gain insight from folks who interact with the regulations in different ways.
