Latest News: Let Congress Know It Cannot Enter Recess Without Approving Additional Funding for Medicaid HCBS Providers

We're hearing that Senate Republicans are hearing your advocacy and negotiating with the White House over funding. But agreement between Senate Republicans is only the first hurdle the legislation must clear; then Republicans and Democrats on Capitol Hill must come together. This makes now a critically important time for us to keep the pressure on to ensure the depth of our needs are communicated and understood.

Congress is scheduled for recess in 18 days, giving us a narrow window to strongly advocate for additional funding for Medicaid HCBS providers to ensure people with disabilities and the DSPs who support them do not remain the #ForgottenFaces of the pandemic.
