# ANCOR Latest News: Senate Republicans Leave HCBS Funding Out of HEALS Act, Their Counter-Proposal to House-Passed HEROES Act





#### #ForgottenFaces Campaign Update: July 30, 2020

Acknowledging those we've lost; working to ensure further lives are spared

Senate Republicans released their draft legislation — the HEALS Act — as a counter-proposal to the HEROES Act, which passed the Democratic-controlled House along party margins in mid-May. While the Senate proposal contained some good provisions for disability supports — see the <u>PDF linked here</u> for a list of them — these provisions cannot be substitutes for increased funding that would go directly to Medicaid HCBS programs, as detailed in the HEROES Act.

We are very disappointed to see legislation that, again, fails to include increased funding for Medicaid HCBS programs. Such funding is necessary for I/DD support agencies ability to purchase personal protective equipment, cover staff overtime and hazard pay and maintain afloat supports such as day and employment services that temporarily closed to maintain social distancing.

Now is the time to loudly and clearly demand Congress cease overlooking these essential supports. We must <u>speak up</u> about the absence of direct increases to Medicaid HCBS programs in the HEALS Act, and let Congress know that they must not again neglect the **#ForgottenFaces** of the COVID-19 pandemic.
