Course for Mobile Crisis Responders

Next Course Begins January 5th, 2020

Registration is open for the next live virtual training course on intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD) for mental health mobile crisis responders. This is one of three courses in the MHIDD Professional Development Series offered by the Center for START Services. It is highly recommended for the following providers:

- Mobile Crisis Responders, Clinicians & Supervisors
- Mental Health and/or IDD Case Managers /Service Coordinators
- Emergency Services Clinicians

The course consists of 6 webinar-style sessions (75 minutes each) that teach best practices in crisis assessment, response, and disposition recommendations. Registration is \$149 per person and participants can receive University of New Hampshire Continuing Education Units and a Certificate of Completion for MHIDD Mobile Crisis Response Training.
