



## Update: PA Family Support Alliance Sponsors Free Online Virtual Mandated Reporter Training

The Pennsylvania Family Support Alliance (PFSA) is continuing to offer virtual Mandated Reporter Training at no cost to mandated reporters in Pennsylvania!

This three-hour virtual training is approved by the Departments of Human Services, Education, and State and meets all of the requirements for training on recognizing and reporting child abuse (to include Act 126 for school employees).

The training is also approved for continuing education credits under Act 31 (Department of State for health-related licenses) and Act 48 (Department of Education for teachers) at no cost. PFSA will submit your training verification to the appropriate department on your behalf (details will be provided during training).
