<i>Updated service definitions and guidance to reflect changes approved in the November 22, 2021 waiver amendments.</i>	
Assistive Technology	Additional clarification was included regarding the Remote Supports component of Assistive Technology.
Community Participation Support	Additional clarification was included regarding the on-call and remote support component of Community Participation Support (CPS)
Residential Habilitation	Additional clarification was included regarding remote supports rendered as part of Residential Habilitation, Life Sharing and Supported Living.
<i>Updated service definitions and guidance to reflect changes approved in the June 1, 2022 waiver amendments.</i>	
Eligibility was expanded to include children with a developmental disability due to a medically complex condition.	The Family Medical Support Assistance service was added to support the complex medical needs of these children.
Delivery of services while the participant is hospitalized.	This is added to various services while the participant is hospitalized. This is currently allowed through Appendix K flexibilities. Guidance regarding delivery of services while the participant is hospitalized is contained in the Operational Guide and should continue to be followed until otherwise notified.

Homemaker	Homemaker services include infection control measures and intensive cleaning such as cleaning medical equipment and disinfecting the home.
Home Accessibility	Home accessibility adaptations support individuals to transition from an institutional setting to a private home (including a Life Sharing home) and clarify covered home accessibility adaptations due to changes in Medical Assistance.
Transition to Independent Living Payments	Added to the Consolidated Waiver to support participants to transition from residential habilitation homes to Life Sharing or Support Living.
Rates	New procedure codes were added for the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Family Medical Support Assistance services; • Medically Complex Life Sharing services in the Consolidated Waiver; and • Transition to Independent Living payments in the Consolidated Waiver.
<i>Other Applicable Updates</i>	
Increase Cap in P/FDS and CLW	A \$41,000 per person per fiscal year total limit was established for the P/FDS Waiver effective January 1, 2022. A \$85,000 per person per fiscal year total limit was established for the Community Living Waiver effective January 1, 2022.
Travel Policy	The provision of waiver services during travel has increased to 90 calendar days per fiscal year.
ISP Key Terms	The definition for direct services is updated and a definition for indirect services is added.
General Billing terms	Updated guidance for billing the 15 Minute Unit of Service and the hour unit of service.
