

Release of Training on Residential Individual Support Plan (ISP) Staffing: *It's About the Person, Not the Numbers* ODP Announcement 22-094

AUDIENCE:

Administrative Entities (AEs), Supports Coordination Organizations (SCOs), Providers of Residential Services in the Consolidated and Community Living Waivers

PURPOSE:

This Office of Developmental Programs (ODP) communication announces the release of the Residential ISP Staffing three-part webcast training located on MyODP at the following link: <https://www.myodp.org/course/view.php?id=2029>.

DISCUSSION:

The Residential ISP Staffing trainings described in ODP Announcement 22-017, which were provided virtually or in-person training, have been completed. To ensure ongoing training is available for new staff or for current staff who may benefit from a review of the content; a three-part training webcast is now available. The training covers the same content as the prior virtual or in-person sessions. The training includes opportunities for participants to apply the concepts through examples and can be taken at a pace appropriate to the needs of the participant and their agency. Participants who complete all requirements will receive 4 hours of training credit. Certificates for past trainings on MyODP are still available in the course where you completed the requirements.
