

Individual Support Plan (ISP) Staffing Sessions for Executive Leadership of Intellectual Disability/Autism (ID/A) Waiver-Funded Residential Providers

AUDIENCE:

Executive Leadership of ID/A Waiver funded Residential Providers

PURPOSE:

To announce open registration for two upcoming sessions focused on the Office of Developmental Programs' (ODP) expectations of Residential Provider Executive Leadership (Chief Executive Officers, Chief Operating Officers, and Executive Directors of Residential Services) in the implementation of the Residential ISP Staffing approach.

DISCUSSION:

The Residential ISP Staffing approach was implemented in 2019. This approach is the required shift from documenting staffing ratios in residential ISPs to describing supervision and support needs related to risk factors that are necessary to help individuals achieve an everyday life. In addition, this approach allows for the best use of staffing resources based on when and how supports are needed.

In these two 90-minutes sessions, ODP Leadership will clarify residential provider expectations for the implementation of the Residential ISP Staffing approach. Executive

Leadership from Residential Provider agencies who participated in the 2019 pilot will discuss their experiences in implementing the Residential ISP Staffing approach, as well as discuss how each agency supported organizational change to facilitate implementation. Also, content highlights from training that will be offered to Program Specialists in 2024 will be reviewed.

ODP strongly recommends that Residential Provider Executive Leadership review the online training *Residential ISP Staffing: It's About the Person, Not the Numbers* prior to attending a session. Contact the MyODP Help Desk if you need assistance accessing the training on MyODP.
