CHC Rate Discussion

- Conducted the Joint Technical Assistance Session on September 20, 2023.
- Individual sessions with each of the CHC-MCOs were held between October 11 and 12, 2023.
- Negotiations are ongoing with hopes of finalizing offers to conclude soon.

Managed Care Quality Report

 The Department recently published an updated Managed Care Quality Strategy in the Pennsylvania Bulletin on September 23, 2023 for a 30-day public comment period - with the comment period closing on October 23, 2023.



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- OLTL's key quality improvement initiatives included requiring value-based purchasing models for long-term services and supports and requiring a pay for performance program to improve the quality of nursing facility services as well as Performance Improvement Program for performance around assessments, care plans reassessments and planning after discharge, Consumer Assessment of Healthcare Providers and Systems (CAHPS) health plan satisfaction and meeting nursing home transition benchmarks.



- OMAP & OMHSAS Joint Bulletin Regarding "Street Medicine"
 - Effective October 1, 2023
 - Informs medical assistance (MA) providers that DHS will cover certain services for MA beneficiaries experiencing unsheltered homelessness in their lived environment, known as street medicine.
 - Covered services include physical and behavioral health services, such as primary care, vaccinations, wound care, counseling, and diagnostics in the lived environment.
