AUDIENCE:

State and Non-State Intermediate Care Facilities for Individuals with an Intellectual Disability (ICF/IIDs), Administrative Entities (AEs), Supports Coordination Organizations (SCOs), Support Coordinators (SCs), Direct Service Providers (DSPs) and Contracted Entities that conduct or perform oversight of Incident Investigations performed by Certified Investigators (CIs)

PURPOSE:

To communicate that the CIPR Course is now available.

DISCUSSION:

All entities that complete investigations are required to conduct the CIPR process as outlined in the CIPR Manual. This course is offered as an opportunity to support entities to complete high-quality CIPRs that help mitigate risks to individuals receiving services.

There are two parts to the course:

- o Part 1: Online module which includes three (3) units and a quiz
- Part 2: Live virtual case study session

The online module is a prerequisite to the virtual case study session. Once the online module is successfully completed, registration will be available for the virtual case study
