In May of 2022, the National Community of Practice for Supporting Families (CoP), supported by the Administration on Community Living (ACL), hosted an inperson Supporting Families Summit in Washington, D.C. to continue the efforts of the 2011 National Agenda for Supporting Families that was a result of the Wingspread Family Support Summit.

The Summit brought together key partners in the supporting families movement to explore the current landscape of supporting families initiatives, develop common definitions and vision for the work, and identify existing and needed policies and practices for enhancing supports to families across the lifespan.
