

Now Available: Home and Community-Based Services (HCBS) Settings Rule Annual Report for Fiscal Year (FY) 2022-2023 ODP Announcement 24-034

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this communication is to inform all interested persons of the availability of the latest annual report that assesses provider compliance with the federal HCBS Rule for the Office of Developmental Programs (ODP).

DISCUSSION:

As part of ODP's commitment to ensuring compliance with the federal HCBS Rule, the latest annual report containing results from ODP licensing inspections and Quality Assessment and Improvement (QA&I) full reviews for FY 2022-2023 is now available [on MyODP](#).

ODP produced the first annual HCBS Rule report in 2021, that covered the period of July 1, 2020, to June 30, 2021, or State Fiscal Year 2020-2021 (FY 20-21). In addition to providing detailed licensing inspection results about compliance with the HCBS Rule, this most recent annual report includes HCBS Rule-related QA&I full review results for FY 22-23 Administrative Entities (AEs), Support Coordination Organizations (SCOs), and Providers and compares the licensing inspection findings in the previous two reports to the findings for FY 22-23 to determine whether and how the findings have changed.
