COURSE OVERVIEW

This workshop provides an overview of common issues and concerns that clinicians may encounter when working with LGBTQ+ youth.

Participants will be encouraged to ponder the clinical, ethical, and practical aspects of brief case scenarios.

COURSE OUTLINE

- Part I will include a review of basic concepts relating to gender and sexual orientation.
- Part II will describe the high rates of youths' self-reported mental health challenges and concerns.
- Part III will address how to create a welcoming clinical environment.
- Part IV will identify a variety of treatment considerations, family dilemmas, and issues to explore in treatment.

This course is intended for Social Workers, Professional Counselors, Marriage and Family Therapists, Graduate Students, and others supporting the mental health and wellbeing of LGBTQ+ youth.


