

Open for Public Comment: Proposed Implementation of Performance-Based Contracting for Residential Services, Waiver Amendments to the Consolidated, Community Living, and Person/Family Directed Waivers, and Rates

ODP Announcement 24-039 Reissue

AUDIENCE:

All Audiences

PURPOSE:

To inform all interested stakeholders of the opportunity to submit public comments on the proposed implementation of Performance-Based Contracting for residential services and proposed amendments to the Consolidated, Community Living, and Person/Family Directed Support (P/FDS) Waivers effective January 1, 2025, as well as proposed rates effective July 1, 2024. **There is a 45-day public comment period that starts on April 20, 2024 and ends on June 4, 2024 at 11:59PM for all proposed changes in this communication. Please note this communication is being reissued. All changes are in red.**

DISCUSSION:

The Office of Developmental Programs (ODP) is pleased to invite public comment on:

- Performance-Based Contracting for residential services scheduled to take effect January 1, 2025,

- Additional waiver amendments (not related to Performance-Based Contracting) to the Consolidated, Community Living, and P/FDS waivers scheduled to take effect January 1, 2025; and
- Rate setting methodology and fee schedule rates scheduled to take effect July 1, 2024.

Overview of the Proposed Changes:

- ODP proposes to implement a 1915(b)(4) waiver for Performance-Based Contracting of Residential Habilitation, Supported Living, and Life Sharing services in the Consolidated and Community Living Waivers. The following documents are available for review:
 - Residential Performance-Based Contracting Implementation Plan. This document was developed to help all interested persons understand why ODP is proposing Performance-Based Contracting for residential services and the actions that will be taken.
 - Section 1915(b)(4) Waiver Fee-For-Service Selective Contracting Program. This is the application that is submitted to CMS that will allow ODP to implement

- Performance-Based Contracting for residential services. ○ Residential Performance Standards. In addition to meeting regulatory requirements and provider qualification requirements in the waivers, providers of residential services will also be required to meet additional requirements called performance standards which were developed to improve the quality of services.
- Consolidated and Community Living Waiver Record of Change to implement Performance-Based Contracting.
- ODP proposes to implement additional changes to the Consolidated, Community Living, and P/FDS Waivers that are not related to Performance-Based Contracting. Proposed changes include:
 - Supporting participants who utilize American Sign Language (ASL) with the addition of an ASL English Interpreter service.
 - Clarifying that participants receiving services in an acute care hospital will not be disenrolled from the waiver and will not require reserved waiver capacity.
 - Adding specific indirect activities that can be billed through the Benefits Counseling service and clarifying that individuals who are not eligible for Work Incentives Planning and Assistance (WIPA) programs can receive Benefits Counseling without being referred to a WIPA program. ○ Revisions to align waiver requirements and provider qualifications with regulatory requirements, correct errors, and provide clarification requested by stakeholders.
- ODP proposes to implement Fee Schedule Rates for services funded through the Consolidated, Community Living, and P/FDS waivers and base-funded program as well as Department-Established Fees for residential ineligible services. Implementation of these rates is dependent on approval by the General Assembly which is part of the state

budget process for Fiscal Year 2024-2025. The following documents are available for review:

 - Proposed Wage Ranges for Agency with Choice and Vendor/Fiscal Employer Agent Services

 - Agency With Choice Rate Assumption Summaries
 - Residential Assumption Summaries
 - Residential Ineligible Assumption Summaries
- The public notice outlines proposed increases to the limits on the maximum dollar amount of Waiver services in Appendix C-4 of the Community Living and P/FDS Waivers to ensure that the proposed changes to the Fee Schedule Rates do not result in a reduction or loss of Waiver services for individuals.
 - The current limit of \$85,000 per person per fiscal year for Community Living Waiver services will be increased to \$97,000. Supports Coordination services will continue to be excluded from this limit.
 - The current limit of \$41,000 per person per fiscal year for P/FDS Waiver services will be increased to \$47,000. Supports Coordination and Supports Broker services will continue to be excluded from this limit. The limit can continue to be exceeded by \$15,000 for Advanced Supported Employment, Supported Employment, or Benefits Counseling services.
