### **COURSE OVERVIEW**

During this workshop, participants will explore the concept of social justice and how it relates professional ethical responsibilities.

Participants will learn how to identify social justice concerns based on a client's psychosocial history and to use practical strategies to advocate for social justice within the boundaries of clinical practice.

## **COURSE OUTLINE**

- Part I will highlight how social justice is addressed in various professional codes of conduct.
- In Part II, participants will learn about relevant economic and political theories, as well as how the concept of social justice has evolved over time.
- Part III will address issues of social justice specific to the mental health system. It will also explain opportunities for addressing social justice issues within an ecological framework.
- In Part IV, a psychosocial history of a family will be presented.

This course is intended for Social Workers, Professional Counselors, Marriage and Family Therapists, Graduate Students, and others supporting the mental health and well-being of children and youth.
