ELIGIBILITY AND GUIDELINES

Eligibility: The PATC Call for Art is open to Pennsylvania residents who are on the autism spectrum.

Deadline: Friday, September 6th, 2024

Content Guidelines: Art must follow these guidelines to be included in the art show:

- You can submit up to 3 pieces of art.
- Do not use profanity or vulgarity.
- Do not include blood, violence, firearms, or injury.
- Do not include sexualized imagery.
- Do not promote hatred against, discrimination, disparage, or humiliate an individual or group of people.
- Do not include imagery relating to recreational drugs or other drug-related content.
- Do not include political themes.

The review committee checks to make sure artwork is not offensive to anyone. They decide what art is eligible.
