

# Now Open: Registration for Certified Investigator (CI) Initial Certification Course

#### **AUDIENCE:**

Administrative Entities (AEs), Supports Coordination Organizations (SCOs), Supports Coordinators (SCs), Direct Service Providers (DSPs) and Contracted Entities that conduct or will conduct critical incident investigations as required under <a href="Incident Management">Incident Management</a>
Bulletin 00- 21-02 and under <a href="Chapter 6100.402">Chapter 6100.402</a> Incident Investigation.

### **PURPOSE:**

To communicate that **registration for the September – December CI Initial Certification Course** cohorts **is now open** in MyODP.

#### **DISCUSSION:**

The Initial CI Certification Course was created to ensure that all incidents requiring an investigation receive a systematic review that meets established standards. To perform investigations, the CI candidate must successfully complete all requirements of the CI Initial Certification Course. The September – December 2024 CI Initial Certification

Course includes live training sessions that are held either in person or virtually.

# The Initial Certification process consists of:

- Verification of the CI candidate's general qualifications (completed by your Office of Developmental Programs' [ODP]-affiliated employer/sponsor)
- Completion of pre-instructional online requirements
- Attendance at all scheduled training sessions for the cohort
  - The in-person version of the course consists of three full days of inperson training
  - The virtual version of the course consists of four 3.5-hour Zoom sessions
- Completion of online lessons, quizzes, and other homework, as assigned
- Passing the online exam
- Enrolling in the recertification cycle
- Downloading the certificate of completion

## **Registration Instructions:**

- You may not register someone else for the course. Each CI candidate must have
   a MyODP account and register themselves while logged into their own
   account.

  the "New Account Form" button. Please do not create a new account if you
  think you may already have one.
