#### Improving On Person-Centered Care by Introducing the 4Ms

Active listening and person-centered care are the groundwork for a new model from the Age Friendly Health Systems called the 4Ms Framework. This training will explain how using the 4Ms framework can enhance resident care. It will also explain what the 4Ms are, why they are important, who should use them, and how to implement or refine current care to utilize the 4Ms. The training includes opportunities for learners to familiarize themselves and practice approaches to integrating the 4Ms into their facility systems. This 6-hour hybrid training includes a 3-hour prerequisite, to be completed online **prior** to attending the live, virtual 3-hour session.
