

Now Available: Certified Investigator Peer Review (CIPR) Live Case Study Sessions

AUDIENCE:

State and Non-State Intermediate Care Facilities for Individuals with an Intellectual Disability (ICF/IIDs), Administrative Entities (AEs), Supports Coordination Organizations (SCOs), Support Coordinators (SCs), Direct Service Providers (DSPs) and Contracted Entities that conduct or perform oversight of Incident Investigations performed by Certified Investigators (CIs)

PURPOSE:

To communicate that **new live case study sessions** for the **Certified Investigator Peer Review** (CIPR) Course are now available.

DISCUSSION:

All entities that complete investigations are required to conduct the CIPR process as outlined in the CIPR Manual. This course is offered as an opportunity to support entities to complete high-quality CI Peer Reviews that help mitigate risks to individuals receiving services.

There are two parts to the CIPR course:

Part 1: Online Module, which includes three (3) units and a quiz

Part 2: Live case study session, held via Zoom

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The online module of the CIPR course can be accessed by logging on to MyODP.org and then clicking on this link: <u>CIPR Training</u>. No registration is needed for the online module.

Successful completion of the online module is a prerequisite to the case study session. After the online module is successfully completed, learners may register for the case study session, whenever these sessions are scheduled throughout the year.
