The Nature of ALR ILOS

- Formalized with 2016 Medicaid and Children's Health Insurance
 Program (CHIP) Final Rule.
- States may cover services or settings that are <u>substitutes</u> for services or settings covered under the state plan.
 - Key words are, "In Lieu of..."
 - ALR ILOS is not a Home and Community-Based Service (HCBS)
 - Also not a Nursing Facility (NF) service
 - ILOS is connected to NF services in that the option sits between the NF and community living.

ILOS is driven by the Community HealthChoices (CHC) Managed Care Organizations (MCOs).

The Nature of ALR ILOS cont.

Center for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS)

ILOS Must

- Advance the objectives of the Medicaid program
- Be cost effective
- · Be medically appropriate
- Preserve participant rights and protections
- Subject to monitoring and oversight
- Subject to retrospective evaluation

Participants cannot be required to use or remain in ILOS.

ILOS is intended to reduce health disparities and address unmet health-related social needs.

Oversight

- CMS requires that ILOS be subjected to appropriate oversight.
 - Multiple OLTL Bureaus collaborating on long-term oversight plan.
 - ALRs assessed by OLTL at application
 - MCOs to monitor for setting appropriateness
- Bureau of Human Services Licensing (BHSL)
 - Responsible for licensure and regulatory compliance of ALRs
 - ALRs are subject to Human Services Licensing Law and 55. PA Code Chapter 20.
 - ALR operations are regulated by 55. PA Code Chapter 2800.
 - BHSL staff receive ILOS training.



Cost of Care

Participants who do not receive Social Security Income (SSI)

 Room and board maximum rates will be determined by the County Assistance Office (CAO) using the same rules and regulations, 55 Pa. Code 181.451 – 181.453, as calculating the patient pay liability for those residing in a NF.

SSI Recipients

- Room and board rates are governed by 55. PA Code Chapter 2800.
- Maximum rates are total income Personal Needs
 Allowance (PNA) of \$85.00 per month.
