Working in Pennsylvania, Delaware, Connecticut, New Jersey, Moldova, and India, we provide individualized, person-directed support for each person accepting our services in the areas of intellectual disabilities, autism, and mental health, as well as Capital Area Head Start and Susquehanna Service Dogs. We offer technical assistance to governments, regulators, and other organizations, and provide educational opportunities to promote inclusion.




Autism Services
