What Is the IM4Q Statewide Steering Committee?

The IM4Q Steering Committee includes people with disabilities, their family members, and others involved in the intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD) service system. They work together to share ideas and make recommendations for improving services and policies.

How It Works:

- The Committee meets for about 2 hours, mostly online, 4 times a year
- Self-advocates and family members are paid for each meeting they attend



What Committee Members Do:

- Help create and update IM4Q survey questions
- Review reports and surveys
- Share feedback and ideas with ODP and its Information Sharing Advisory Committee (ISAC)
- Help make sure everyone's voices are heard
- Help plan and attend the Annual Statewide Training
- Help choose and review IM4Q local programs when necessary
