PURPOSE:

To announce that a new Participant Directed Services training, “Understanding, Promoting, and Monitoring Participant Directed Services in Pennsylvania,” is now available on MyODP.

DISCUSSION:

In Pennsylvania, Individuals with Developmental Disabilities have choice and control over the services and supports they receive, regardless of their preferred delivery method. For those living independently or with family, Participant Directed Services offer the opportunity to tailor their supports to effectively meet their unique needs.

This training series was developed to help ensure County Programs/ Administrative Entities and Supports Coordinators fully understand the Participant Directed Services available so they can effectively inform individuals and families about their options and encourage them to consider this approach.

This training consists of 7 webcasts, for a total viewing time of about 81 minutes.

Completion of a 30 question Post Test is required for training credit. Once completed, 2 credit hours will be awarded on the MyTranscript report.
